Feast of St. Bakhita/ Awareness of Human Trafficking, Saturday, February 8: The Catholic Church has a strong commitment to eradicating modern slavery, a stance grounded in Catholic Social Teaching. "At its heart the call to eradicate modern slavery and human trafficking is a call to make a choice for respecting the intrinsic and inalienable dignity of every human person" (Archbishop Fisher, 2018). Let us pray, *O St. Bakhita, assist all those who are trapped in a state of slavery; Intercede with God on their behalf so that they will be released from their chains of captivity. Those whom man enslaves, let God set free. Provide comfort to survivors of slavery and let them look to you as an example of hope and faith. Help all survivors find healing from their wounds. We ask for your prayers and intercessions for those enslaved among us. Amen.*

World Day of the Sick, Tuesday, February 11: this day is dedicated to praying for the sick and appreciating those who care for them. Please join in the rosary prayer service at 2:00. Refreshments will follow the service.
