What is a plenary indulgence? It is a remission of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven. It is a particularly powerful way to obtain remission of punishment on earth or in purgatory that would have resulted from sins that were already forgiven.

St. Patrick's Day, Monday, March 17: There are several popular legends about how St. Patrick used the shamrock to explain the mystery of the Trinity. According to one legend, St. Patrick, when asked for an explanation of the Trinity, bent down, picked a shamrock, and explained how the three leaves are part of the one plant, and how similarly the three Persons, Father, Son, and Spirit, are part of one Supreme Being.
