

# From the Pastor's Desk

### The Chrism Mass

Dear Friends,

The Chrism Mass is a special liturgical celebration in the Catholic Church. It will be held on April 10, Thursday at 7 pm at St. Patrick's Cathedral, Thunder Bay, presided over by our newly consecrated and installed Bishop Most Rev. Allan C. This will be his first ever Chrism mass with his diocesan clergy and faithful.

The Bishop consecrates three holy oils used in sacraments throughout the year: The Oil of Catechumens, The Oil and The Sacred Chrism. All priests present in the chrism mass renew their commitment to serve Christ and His Church, reaffirming their vows of obedience to the bishop. The Chrism Mass highlights the unity of the priests with their bishop and the faithful, showing the Church as one body in Christ.

Since it occurs just before the Holy Week, the Chrism Mass connects the Church's sacramental life with the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus. It is a solemn and beautiful liturgy that emphasizes the sacred role of the sacraments and the mission of the Church in bringing Christ's grace to the world.

You can pray for all the priests all over the world on that day and keep supporting them.




