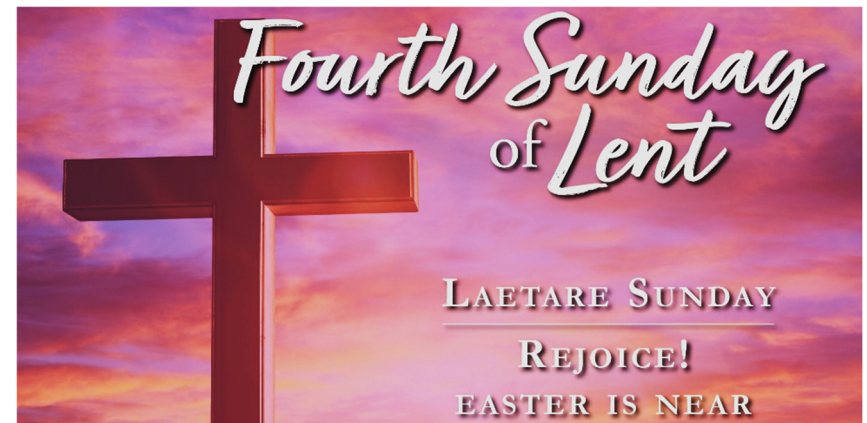
FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

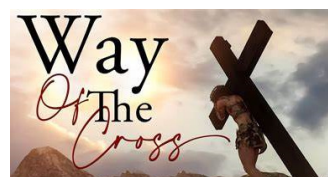
